





Christ's Seven Last Words

Featuring seven speakers as they reflect on the Last Words of Christ.

The Stations of the Cross has been a universal way of reenactment or atonement participation in the suffering of our Lord's last journey, carrying his cross, in Jerusalem since post-Roman times. Stopping at each remembered place along Christ's way reminds the sojourners of His sacrifice to encourage reflection and contemplation. Its inspiration came from the desire to imitate the journeys of early Christian pilgrims to the Holy Land, especially to the places of Christ's redemptive suffering.

Artist's Renderings

In 2007, Rev. AJ Thomas approached Dr. Cynthia Taylor and Cheap Joe's Art Stuff Corporation with a request to create visuals for the Good Friday Service. Dr. Taylor set about sketching the fourteen pictures by studying Rembrandt etchings and Christian icons. She then used a DVD of the story of Christ for her renderings. She would freeze frame on scenes which interested her. Pencil sketches were the studies for her selections. Depictions were composed, while looking at the screen, in black, felt tip marker. Each image, in the words of the artist, required much prayer.

Cheap Joe's Art Stuff Corporation and the Upper Room Sunday School Class have matted and framed the works of art. They will be on display for prayer and meditation on Good Friday.
