RISE facilitates relationships across economic, cultural and racial dividing lines allowing participants to overcome present and/or persistent barriers and to expand opportunities through education, life-skills, and community service.

Humanitarian relief project from NC UMCs to the Armenian people in the Artsakh/Karabagh region; this is the only relief organization allowed into this country. They support an orphanage, a Christian Education Center, a cattle/chicken project, building teams, personnel, and give away 5,000 Christmas Shoeboxes.

- Pray for peace along the border with Azerbijan- that the truce will be kept
- Pray for God's continued blessing on this Christian community in the Middle East
- o Pray for donations and people to meet needs in the area

Farm-Hope-Thrive (Tanzania)

Spreading the love and hope of Christ through Farming God's Way, a sustainable agriculture program

- Pray for the completion of 4 additional classrooms for Ormee Primary School in Mairowa, Tanzania
- Pray for additional full-time and part-time missionaries who are called to take part in this ministry
- Pray for Godly wisdom, peace, and confirmation of decisions as they walk the journey of faith ahead

ZOE (Rwanda & India)

Empowering vulnerable children to overcome poverty through a three-year empowerment program

- Pray for the leaders trained and mobilized in 83 countries as they seek to spread the Gospel in their countries

THE PERSECUTED CHURCH:

- Pray for "Restricted" countries, where government endorsed, anti-Christian laws lead to the persecution and deaths of Christians and severely limit access to the Bible and other Christian literature
- For "Hostile" countries, where governments attempt to protect Christians, but where they routinely experience persecution from family, friends, and neighbors
- o For "Monitored" countries, where persecution of Christians is increasing

BUMC Youth Mission Trips

- Pray for safety traveling

- o Pray for a real sense of community to continue to grow among students, & between students and adults

Grandfather Home for Children/Children's Hope Alliance

Providing a safe, healing journey for hurting children & families - creating hope now and in the future

- o Pray that children can get a healthy start and begin experiencing hope now and for their future
- o Pray for children walking through their healing journey from severe trauma, neglect and abuse
- o Pray for staff as they care for and walk alongside the children they serve
